1	Reserve the Booth and key from the Equipment Checkout form online.
2	Read through your narrationseveral times to get flow for your tone, pacing, and articulation of words and volume of voice.
3	Speak clearly and articulately, keep the volume of your voice at a consistent tone throughout your narration.
4	Read your narration as if you are telling a story to your friend. Engage your audience- Remember if you aren't interested in your story, why should anyone else be?
5	Log into the iMac with your BU credentials, open the program Audacity, and make sure the input (next to the microphone icon) reads, "Shure Digital" Shure Digital 2 (Stereo) Reco 2
6	Audacity will produce two items, a data folder and .aup file. These two are dependant on each other* *-do not separate them.
7	Make sure to export your final audio project, in addition to saving. Saving only saves the project, exporting allows others to listen to it.
